As you are aware we have been planning a celebration tour of South Australia for the week 15 – 22 September 2012.

The initial itinerary is for a tour event around the wine and Murray regions adjacent Adelaide, here is a brief guide to the week's tour. We are planning on running this event similarly to the very successful Tassie trips organised by Tony Bennetto. We will book accommodation (most probably cabin style in caravan parks to keep costs down) and then provide a route and basic itinerary for the days various activities - with plenty of room to make your own plans!

Saturday 15 September - Short run to Hahndorf and Adelaide Hills - back to Adelaide for welcome function Saturday evening.

Sunday 16 September - Run Adelaide to Tanunda (Barossa Valley) via Birdwood Mill Motor Museum overnight Tanunda

Monday 17 - Tanunda to Clare Valley - Overnight Clare

Tuesday 18 - Clare Valley – Spend the day exploring the best of the Clare Valley - Overnight Clare

Wednesday 19 - Clare to Murrumbidgee – Via historic Burra and the Mallee - Five ferry crossing commence (Morgan, Swan Reach) - Overnight Mannum

Thursday 20 - Mannum to Goolwa/Victoria Harbor - Ferry Crossing Continue - Walker Flat, Pernong and Wellington. Explore all the best for the river Murray close to Adelaide and continue the adventure of the ferries that crisscross the river.

Friday 21 - Victoria Harbor - Southern Fleurieu Peninsular - Overnight Victoria Harbor. Experience the treasures of the Fleurieu.

Barossa Valley

The Barossa has a rich food and wine culture that is reflected in its premium wine production, abundant seasonal produce and specialty food products which include artisan cheese and breads, unique smoked and cured meats. Experience the great premium wine, fabulous food, heritage architecture and warm, friendly community. Enjoy a wealth of diverse activities amid a stunning Australian landscape of rolling hills, manicured vineyards and closely linked towns and villages.

Clare Valley

Settled in the 1840s and named after County Clare in Ireland, the Clare Valley has it all. There are heritage towns and trails, boutique wineries, museums and galleries. Fleeing religious persecution in Silesia (now part of Poland), Jesuit priests planted the first vines in 1851. While they still produce their sacramental wine, there's so much more to enjoy, including some of the world's best Riesling. Linked by scenic roads and framed by farms and vines, the Clare Valley is an idyllic combination of the practical and picture postcard.

Murraylands

South Australia's Murraylands region has it all. Just one hour's drive from Adelaide, the Murraylands is home to the mighty Murray River which carves its way through the centre of the region. The lush river environment contrasts with the haunting landscapes of the Mallee, creating a holiday destination that's diverse, fascinating and fun.

Fleurieu Peninsula

The Fleurieu Peninsula's green hills are bounded by clifftops, beaches, coves and the winding Murray River. The river pans out and forms a beautiful, calm pool at Goolwa. Sit on the wharf and see boats cruise under the Hindmarsh Bridge. Get close to kangaroos in the conservation parks. Watch little penguins come ashore at Granite Island. Feel the sand between your toes and hunt for cockles. Take a charter trip and hook a fish. Cycle along the coast or stop by the wineries and find that special drop.

We are looking at securing a range of accommodation and to do this we need to plan for numbers and several. We are seeking a non-refundable deposit of **\$100** if you are planning on joining us for the week – or if you like **\$20** per day if you're planning on only spending a day or two on the tour. These fees will come off any accommodation costs.
