10. CVRS

- New rules take effect from 1/7/17
- Now called Club Registration Scheme
- Clubs can determine what qualifies for Club’s own purposes
- Individual owners are responsible for their car being roadworthy and street legal
- 30 year rolling period has been re-introduced
- Legally modified vehicles still have to be approved by Regency Park
- LHD and RHD vehicles will be treated the same – exemption is still required for LHD
- Statutory declarations will no longer be required, unless replacing a lost log book
- Clubs can elect to inspect vehicles and this is the intention for our club.

Don Cardone, Gordon Boyce and Michael McClaren are considering the code of practice and various fact sheets. Guidelines will be prepared for endorsement by the club. Michael and Don reported on the launch at Football Park yesterday. There were hundreds of cars – lots of Hot-rods, chrome and LHD’s. There may be Sprites with modifications that may now be eligible for the scheme and their owners may wish to join the club.

Lots of discussion followed about modifications and where the authority lies - with the club or Regency Park. The onus is on the owner to drive a legally approved vehicle on the road. Question remains as to how true to form we wish to be and what range of vehicles will be admitted to the club.
