The Federation corrected the error and explained that, provided correct Conditionally Registered Vehicle procedures are followed then a person holding a current valid license can operate that vehicle.

ServicesSA was made aware of this error and will take appropriate action.

The Federation pointed out that the correct procedure for members requiring Conditionally Registered Vehicles is as follows :-

First ask your club and if they cannot answer your question, then they will contact the Federation and if they do not have the answer they will contact the Department to confirm the correct information. This procedure will minimize time wasting for a Departmental officer, regarding information which may be readily available at your club or from the Federation or their website, under the listing "Club Registration FAQ's".
