Technical Tip (#8)

Spark Plugs. Car suddenly running a 'bit off' and misfiring? Maybe consider giving it a new set of plugs before you strip the carburettors down or start adjusting the timing. Remember to re-gap the plugs to around 25tho before you wack them in (unless you are running modern ignition system, then you may be able to open them up to 30-35tho). And don't get sucked in to thinking you can get a little more power out of running 'colder plugs'. Unless you are racing and therefore running fairly constantly at high revs, all these are going to do is foul up and cause the car to cough and splutter.

If you haven't given them a new set of plugs in a while, treat it to a set. It will reward you!
