Technical Tip (#9)

Spring has sprung and now it's time to spring on some fresh oil for your car if you haven't done so over winter! And get your hands on your grease gun and push some fresh grease through all of the grease nipples. Your car will thank you!

But how may of us think of our tyres? We roll our cars out, check they have air in them and some of us even check for tread, but who every thinks about how old they are? And how old is really, well, old, for a tyre that is? Did you know that the year and week of manufacture is stamped on modern every tyre? In the image (below) it's the 47th week of 2014, so late November, early December. It's a safe bet that if its not stamped, its well past its used by date and I'll admit, my spare falls into this category! It's an Olympic tyre and d they stopped making them in 2008!



And how long will they last? Depending on which tyre company you talk to, the replacement age is between 6 and 10 years irrespective of the amount of tread that is left. This is because the rubber degrades over time as its exposed to sunlight, air temperature and even simply the air, and that's before you consider the surfaces that you've driven over and the effects of the pressure that you run you tyres at. From past professional experience, the results of old tyres can be catastrophic.

So spare a thought for your tyres, even your spare and happy motoring!

The iconic Bay to Birdwood is one of the world's great historic motoring events and has been a standout fixture on the South Australian events calendar since 1980.


