5. Treasurers report: Kerry presented February 2024 report which were accepted by the meeting. Moved Sean Power seconded Phillip Kies. Copies attached.
6. Webmaster: Robin advised that all appeared to be working & Matthew Garcia would undertake a review on the system.
7. Club Registration: Two new log books were issued for the month no new cars were inspected.
8. Competition Report: Pat gave a brief review of forthcoming supersprints with a reminder of the Peter Hall six hour regularity event on 5th May.
